## **LTM 1500-8.1 for WWN Guindastes: focus on versatility and performance**

The Brazilian company WWN Guindastes has purchased a used LTM 1500-8.1 from Liebherr. It is the second crane of this model in WWN Guindastes' fleet and will be used on work that calls for a long reach and high load capacities. The LTM 1500-8.1 will be used on various assignments that call for a long reach and high load capacities, such as the dismantling of cranes and the installation of prefabricated components. With this procurement, the crane company is boosting its capacities for handling major projects.
